Two and three-person federation mechanics as well as three person men's and woman's college mechanics will be taught according to your preference. Classroom sessions will cover rules, mechanics and philosophies of the game. *If you just recently in the past few years passed your PIAA officials test, or are going to take your PIAA test in the future, then this is the place for you to get the best schooling in becoming a quality basketball official.*

The camp will be held in conjunction with the **University of Pittsburgh Panther's Team Camp**, which will allow officials to work games that will feature future collegiate basketball players from Pennsylvania, Ohio, New York, West Virginia, etc. This is a very competitive team camp consisting of Varsity players and JV players for the less experienced officials. The games will be played on campus utilizing the new state of the art facility - **Petersen Events Center**, the newly renovated Fitzgerald Fieldhouse, and Trees Hall.



Housing will be available in air-conditioned dormitories and meals provided on the University of Pittsburgh Campus for Registered Resident Campers.
